- a) Grass Cutting TJB Gardening services are carrying out the grass cutting in the village. The grass will be cut once a fortnight throughout the summer months at a cost of £80.00.per cut.
- b) **School Parking and traffic matters**; The costs of the 'H' markings at drive entrances is to be requested from NYCC. The Highways dept are to be asked for more information on the timings of the yellow lining in Orchard Close and the possible installation of verge bollards on the A162. The local PSCO is to be contacted to request a visit during busy school periods. An email had been circulated regarding a zoom meeting about the latest information on the national 20's Plenty campaign.
- Barkston in Bloom =- the clerk is to purchase five half barrels to use as planters, three to be
 placed at the end of Ash Tree Garth to stop on pavement parking and two to be placed near
 to the village notice board,

The existing flower beds would be re planted at the end of May.

Phil Williams is to investigate suitable low level planting to increase the width of the west facing flower bed on the triangle.
